Step 1 Know the Basics

Step 2

Discover Your Context

- Gather information about the jail and religious programs.
- Set up a meeting with the "Gatekeeper".

Step 3

Meet with the Gatekeeper

- Guidelines and questions for meeting with the "Gatekeeper".
- Tool: Jail Ministry Needs Checklist.

Step 4

Match Needs with Resources

- List your Church resources and identify the jail ministry areas your Church will address.
- Tool: Church Resources and Ministry Match.

Step 5

Champion the Ministry

- Share the ministry areas with the congregation.
- Recruit others to pray and serve on the ministry team.
- Tools: Communication tools.

Step 6

Train Ministry Workers

- Participate in the jail's volunteer training.
- Read Christian Volunteer Jail Handbook
- Participate in trainings (see Resources)

Serve

 Serve with a humble heart, showing and sharing the love of Christ.
