

Tim Curington's Bio:

Tim Curington grew up in a pastor's home in the small town of Amelia, Ohio, just outside Cincinnati. He accepted Jesus Christ as his personal Savior at the age of five, led to the Lord by his mother, and surrendered his life to preach the gospel at age 14 during church camp. After graduating from Christian school, Tim attended Hyles-Anderson College, where he met his wife.

For the first 15 years of their marriage, Tim and his wife served faithfully in local church ministry—including leadership, teaching, coaching sports, leading worship, and outreach. Tim also served as the administrative pastor at Liberty Baptist Church in Durham, North Carolina, overseeing church finances. During these years, God blessed them with four children: Titus, Kaelyn, Kourtney, and Thaddaeus.

Following God's leading, Tim and his family stepped away from large-church ministry to help plant a new church. In that transition, he sought work that would support both his family and his calling. He joined Prison Alliance (formerly Christian Library International), where he has served for four years—first as Operations Director and, for the past two years, as Executive Director—advancing the gospel behind bars.
